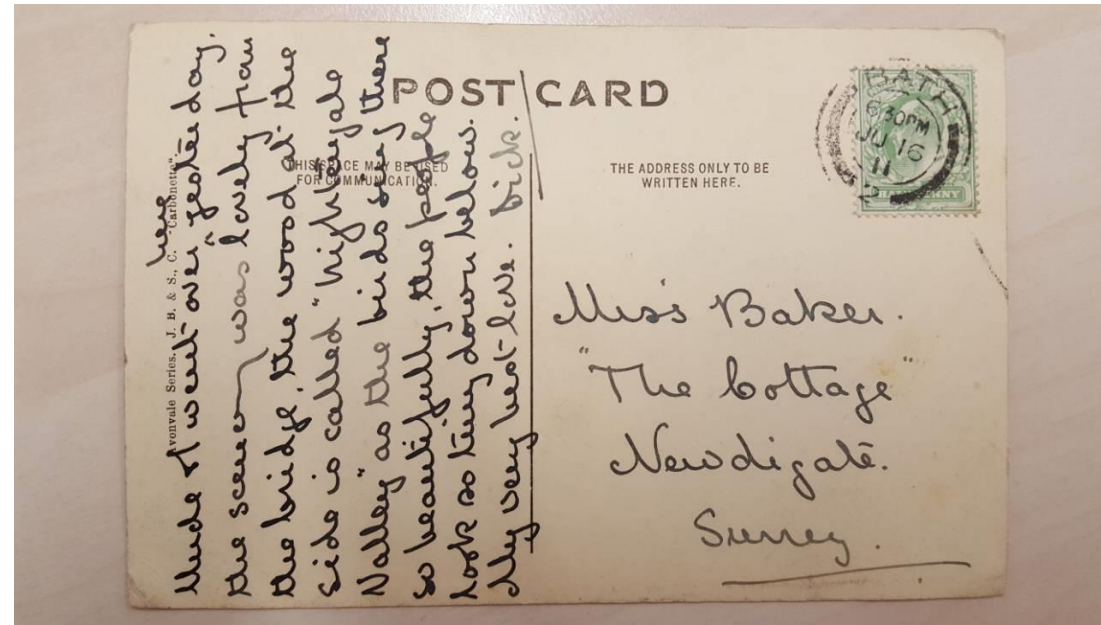


Write a postcard
