1. If you go to the big roundabout by the bus station, you're in for a big surprise! What do we Bristolians call this hole in the ground? (7)
2. This lazy giant left a footprint at Blaise Castle. Perhaps you've also seen his chair? (5)
3. You won't find a big top or a trapeze artist here – but you might be able to buy some huge shoes, a wig and a bowtie! (5/6)
4. An Oscar winning film maker, who is crackers about sheep, rabbits, dogs and chickens. This clue is almost hard, man! (4/4)
5. This famous Bristol artist used to monkey around. Although his work is all over the city, it 'can' be hard to catch him unless you exit through the gift shop. (6)
6. Bristol actor Dave Prowse used the force when he played one of the world's most famous space villains. Most impressive. (5/5)
