

Public Consultation - November 2020

Scheme Overview

The Clifton Suspension Bridge Trust is bringing forward proposals to improve the toilet facilities on the Clifton approach to the Bridge.

The proposal is to re-design the internal layout to provide two modern unisex cubicles and one accessible toilet, plus an education space and a small kiosk. The toilets will continue to be available to the public during daylight hours and the kiosk will serve daily from 10am – 5pm, in keeping with the opening hours of the main Visitor Centre.

We welcome feedback on these proposals from the local community and other stakeholders, which will help inform the final scheme which will be submitted for planning. The closing date for submitting feedback is 11 December 2020.
