BRIDGE BUILDING CHALLENGE

Our bridge-building workshop not only encourages problem-solving, creativity, and teamwork, but it also introduces basic engineering concepts to pupils in an engaging and hands-on way.

HISTORY DETECTIVES



This workshop combines historical exploration, visual analysis, and hands-on writing; it provides pupils with a unique and immersive learning experience on the history of postcards.

BE THE BRIDGE MASTER

In this workshop, you'll be asked to take on the role of Bridge Master and be responsible for the maintenance of the bridge. You'll face several challenges, including budgeting and weighing up the pros/cons. This workshop is an excellent introduction to the operational management of the bridge and a good opportunity for STEM learning.

IF THE BRIDGE HAD EARS

This educational day is an exploration of sound through the ears of the Clifton Suspension Bridge, and consists of an interlinked bridge tour and workshop session.
